P2: Dear students, teachers, and guests, our today's conference deals with the problems of environmental protection. Our planet is a small part of the universe, but it's the only place where human beings can live.

P3: Our planet, what are you like? (На екрані вид Землі з космосу.)

P4: You are green with green grass, forests and woods. (На екрані демонструються картини природи.)

P5: You are blue with lakes, rivers, seas and oceans. (На екрані демонструється морський краєвид.)

P6: You are yellow with spring flowers and sunlight. (Зображення квітучого луку, сонячної галявини тощо.)

P7: You are red with people's blood and terrible fires. (Кадри на тему війни, пожежі тощо. Музика стає тривожною.)

(Учні повертаються. Зворотній бік кожної «планети» чорний.)

All: You are black and dirty with rubbish, waste and radioactivity.

(На екрані труби хімкомбінатів, забруднені річки, звалища сміття, кадри із Чорнобиля, великі міста, вирубка лісів тощо.)

P1: What have they done to the seas, my friend?

P2: Well, they've turned all the seas
And they've killed all the fish in those seas.

And they've poured out
their oil and their waste

P2: Different kinds of people telling me the snow is white,
In former days the grass was green, the sun was really bright.
You have to fight for the Earth, that's OK.

P3: Nowadays the words 'environment', 'pollution', 'ecology' and others are on everyone's lips. What do they mean? Here is our ecological vocabulary.

P4: Ecology is a division of biology concerned with the relationship between living things.

P5: Environment means what is around us.

P6: Greenhouse effect is the phenomenon by which the earth's atmosphere traps some of the sun's heat as it radiates from the earth's surface.

P7: Ozone layer is a region in the upper atmosphere containing a high amount of ozone gas that absorbs the sun's radiation.

P8: Global warming is the increase in world temperature due to the greenhouse effect.

P1: Rain forests are a moist, densely wooded area with lots of rainfalls.

P2: Endangered species are animals that are threatened with extinction.

P3: Harmful waste is nuclear waste or an industrial by-product that is dangerous for the environment and harmful to the health and well-being of living organisms.

P4: Recycling is the process Of collecting used products and remanufacturing them into new products in-stead of throwing them away as garbage.

P5: Energy efficient means using little energy.

WHAT HAVE THEY DONE TO THE RAIN?

P6: Just a little rain falling all around,
The grass lifts its head to the heavenly sound.
Just a little rain, just a little rain,
What have they done to the rain?
Just a little breeze out of the sky,
The leaves nod their heads as the breeze blows by,
Just a little breeze with some smoke in its eye,
What have they done to the rain?

P7: Just a little boy, standing in the rain,
The gentle rain that falls for years,
And the grass is gone, the boy disappears,
And the rain keeps falling like helpless tears,
And what have they done to the rain?

P8: Another great problem of mankind is rubbish. Throw away less rubbish! We can also burn or recycle a lot of it.

P9: In Denmark, for example, it's illegal to sell drinks in cans. And it's not just governments that can produce less rubbish. It's ordinary people, too. For example, anyone can decide to buy products with as little packaging as possible; use and throw away fewer carrier bags; waste less paper.

P10: Turn rubbish into energy by burning it. This is a good idea because it saves fossil fuels; means burying less rubbish; cuts pollution — energy from rubbish is cleaner and cheaper than energy from fossil fuels.

P1: No doubt, litter at the roadside, in the wood or near the river is ugly. How long it will stay before decaying may be an unpleasant surprise. For example, a tin can stay 100 years, a plastic bottle - 450 years and a glass bottle can last thousands of years.

P2: But a lot of things we consider to be litter are still useful. It is possible, in fact, to recycle 80% of domestic rubbish. Recycling saves trees, energy, money...

P3: Britain gets rid of 7 million tones of paper every year. That's the same as 80 million trees. Britain produces 8.5 million cans per year. That's enough to go to the moon and back.

P4: In one year, a European family with two children throws away 50 kilos of paper (that's six trees), 60 kilos of metal and 45 kilos of plastic. The problem is that recycling is expensive. But recycling helps fight the environmental problems.

P5: Another great danger for mankind is radioactivity. Here is the nuclear power data bank. The fuel which nuclear power stations use is a rare metal — uranium. One ton of uranium can produce as much energy as 20,000 tons of coal. Nuclear power doesn't pollute the atmosphere like fossil fuels. But it does produce waste. This waste stays radioactive for thousands of years and is very dangerous.

P6: In April 1986, there was an explosion at the Chornobyl' nuclear power station. The trouble is that the accident caused the contamination of not only a '30 kilometres zone', but it spread to many parts of Ukraine and some other countries. The radioactive cloud reached as far as Scandinavia and Western Europe. The explosion at the nuclear power station did a great damage to people's health, forests and agriculture. Since the Chornobyl' disaster, many countries have stopped building new nuclear power stations. Green organisations all over the world are fighting against nuclear energy.

P7: The question is: how can each of us contribute to keeping the environment cleaner and safer?

P8: We should throw away less rubbish.

P9: We shouldn't leave litter after a picnic.

P10: We can plant trees.

P1: Factories and plants should work on the closed cycle use of water.

P2: We should try to use less water.

P3: We should try to use less energy.

P4: We should spend less water. - P5: We should use less washing powder.

P6: We should take care of animals and plants.
